Care Provision

Personalised care plans are at the centre of our provision, enabling you to be involved in how you would like to experience your care and holiday. Our highly qualified, motivated and experienced team are available 24 hours a day* to provide you with our top quality care provision.

*Currently night care is via a call system. Speak to our care team to discuss your night care needs.

With the support of district nurses where required our team will provide:

- · Assistance with moving and handling
- Administration of medication tablets, ointments, inhalers, nebulisers
- · Assistance with washing and dressing
- · Assistance with packing and unpacking
- · Assistance with meals
- · Catering for special diets
- Assistance with continence care catheters, stomas, suppositories etc.
- Provision of airflow mattresses (subject to availability)

Although one-to-one care is not offered as standard, bespoke packages may be available for those with more complex needs.

Accommodation
