

## Our Location



Calvert Kielder is situated in a 40-acre woodland site within the spectacular Kielder Water & Forest Park and Northumberland International Dark Skies Park.

If using Google maps as your preferred Satellite navigation system, please be sure to use both our **Name** and **Postcode** in the search box and it will bring you directly to us. If you find yourself being directed up any single track forest roads, please stop and head back to the main road, as you are going the wrong way and very well may get stuck!

Driving is the best way to get to the centre as we are not served by public transport. Our nearest train station is in the market town of Hexham, 29 miles away. We do operate transfers with our accessible minibuses on specific days. Please contact our Guest Services team if you would like to enquire about booking transport on 01434 250232.

## How to Find Us

### From the South and East of England

- Head for Newcastle Upon Tyne and follow the A1 until you see signs for Hexham A69.
- Follow the A69 just past Hexham until a turning on the right of the dual carriageway signs towards Acomb and Chollerford A6079.
- Follow this road through Acomb, Wall and up to Chollerford, at which point brown tourist information signs start signalling the way to 'Kielder Water and Forest'. Other signs to look for are Wark and Bellingham. You should now be on the B6320. Stay on this road all the way to Bellingham.
- From Bellingham, follow signs for Kielder Water and Forest. Approx. 10 miles.
- Entering into Kielder Water & Forest Park you will pass Tower Knowe Visitor Centre on the right. Calvert Kielder is a further 3.5 miles along this road on the left hand side, set back just off the main road (do not head off up any dirt track/forest roads). We are clearly signposted and have a small stone walled entrance.

### From the West of England and South of Scotland

- Leave the M6 at Junction 44 Carlisle and follow A7 through Longtown.
- On approaching the next village of Canonbie, brown tourist information signs start signalling the way to 'Kielder Water and Forest' on B6357.
- Stay on the B6357 and pass through the village of Newcastleton. In a further 8 miles, turn right and keep following the tourist signs for Kielder. Kielder Village is now roughly a 6.5 mile journey.
- Upon entering Kielder Village, stay on the main road past the petrol station. Calvert Kielder is a further 6 miles along the road on the right hand side, set back just off the main road (do not head off up any dirt track/forest roads). We are clearly signposted and have a small stone walled entrance.
